	Swimming in neoprene wetsuits is permitted.  Bathing caps will be provided by the organiser and are		
	mandatory, as they help to ensure visibility and safety.		
Further information	Information mails containing links and news or changes will be sent to all participants in the 3rd week and the final week prior to the start date. Please inform us immediately if you have not received any mail three weeks beforehand at the e-mail address you specified on registration.		
Time recording	Time recording will be carried out using a Timit transponder that will be provided by the organiser.  The transponders must be handled with care and returned following the event. A fee of 80 euros (cost of the transponder) will be charged in the event of loss or damage.		
Registration	Registration will take place online via our homepage with link to Raceresult from 1 <sup>st</sup> October 2023. Inclusion in the starting list will take place once payment of the starting fee has been received.  The closing date for registering is 11 <sup>th</sup> August 2024. Late entries (without T-shirts & sponser kits) will be possible the day before the event. If a high number of participants are set to take part starting will take place in several groups spaced approx. Siminutes apart.  On registering, participants affirm that they are physically healthy. They also affirm that they are sufficiently fit to complete the target distance and that they are aware of the circumstances of swimming in open water.
